Street Tree Inventory Project



Join PP&R Urban Forestry to map, measure, and identify 50,000+ trees in 2015!

Volunteers with all skill levels are needed in the following roles:

Inventory Team Leader: Attend a training and commit to participate in at least three inventory workdays. Improve your tree ID skills and learn more about assessing tree health and site conditions. Trainings are offered 8:30 am – noon or 1 – 4:30 pm on these days:

Data collection on Inventory Work Days: You will be paired with a trained Team Leader who will teach you inventory protocol. Together you will collect data on trees and the site. Most work days are Saturday or Wednesday from 8:30 am – noon, but some Wednesdays are evening events.

Data entry at Urban Forestry Headquarters: Learn to use ArcGIS 10.2 to enter data at Urban Forestry's North Portland office. No experience necessary – we will teach you the basics! Shifts available Mon.-Fri. from 7:00 am – 3:30 pm. A 30-hour minimum commitment. Trainings will be offered:

Serve as an Arborist-on-Call during Inventory: For professional arborists only. Arborists-on-Call check in with inventory teams to problem solve on questions of tree ID, condition assessment, high voltage wire recognition and other issues that arise on volunteer work days.

Join your neighborhood Tree Team: Each neighborhood Tree Team is responsible for securing locations, advertising and recruiting volunteers. After inventories are complete, they work with their communities to create a tree plan for stewardship of the urban forest. If you live in an inventory neighborhood and want a long-term commitment to improving your neighborhood's canopy, this may be for you!
